


University of Utah Health Care




Boston Children's Hospital




Boston Children's Hospital Pedestrian Bridge and Parking Garage

Art, signage, and donor recognition elements throughout the garage and pedestrian bridge were inspired by patterns in DNA sequencing. The environmental art strategy includes a 3-story dimensional mural and backlit photo-mosaic of a child's face made up of hundreds of photos of staff and families collected during the 150th anniversary of the hospital.

Signage details include illumination and patterning that compliment Elkus Manfredi's architectural design. 




Dana-Farber Chestnut Hill






